



Public Consultation Notice: Proposed Safeguarding Fence at the Boundary of St Peter's Church of England Primary School

Following a recent external safeguarding review, Galileo Multi Academy Trust is consulting on a proposal to erect a safeguarding fence along the boundary of the school playing field at St Peter's CoE Primary School, which backs onto properties 72–104 Marshall Drive.

The safeguarding review highlighted the need to strengthen the security of the school site. As part of our duty to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all pupils, staff, and visitors, the review recommended the installation of a new boundary fence along the rear of the school field.

We wish to make local residents aware of the proposal and invite comments before any work takes place.

Purpose of the Consultation

Before submitting a planning application, we are required to carry out a 21-day public consultation. We value the views of our local community and welcome your feedback on the proposal.

Details of the Proposed fence

- Location: St Peter's CoE Primary school, Marshall Dr, Saltburn-By-The-Sea TS12 2UW
- The fence will be 2 metres in height.
- It will be a green, metal, weld-mesh style fence, chosen for durability and minimal visual impact.
- It will be installed approximately 1 metre inside the school boundary, running parallel to the rear of the 17 properties that back onto the school field.
- No access to your property will be required at any stage of the installation.

The purpose of the fence is to enhance safeguarding by clearly defining the school perimeter and reducing the risk of unauthorised access to the site.
